Learn about different kinds of fairly traded products. Talk about the benefits of fair trade in the world.

Learn about endangered animals and transform yourself into an endangered animal by making a mask or costume. Why is your chosen animal endangered and how could we save them? You might include polar bears, Siberian tigers, white rhinos, mountain gorillas and loggerhead sea turtles.
