Point out some of the things that are in the night sky

For this part of the badge you need to point out some of the things that we can see in the night sky, this could include pointing out the moon or a one of the planets. Point out and name at least one constellation in the night sky

This part of the badge is very similar to the first section but this time you need to point out some of the star constellations that you can see. Most of the stars you can see in the night sky are part of constellations which means they make up a shape or a group. See if you can spot some of the following constellations: Orion's Belt, or the Three Sisters; Ursa Major, or the Saucepan. Once you have found them in the sky use the box below to write which one you saw and if you are feeling creative you could draw a picture of the stars within them.

Name the eight planets in our solar system and draw or create a model of one of the planets

For this section you need to create a model of one of the planets. This can be made out of anything but when you have completed your model take a photo of it and upload it to Online Scout Manager.
